

2017-18 SORC ISLANDS IN THE STREAM SERIES SCORING

Three-quarters of the way through the 2017-18 SORC Islands in the Stream Series finds Todd Stuart's Swan 56 "White Rhino" still holds a one point lead over Jim Bill, Eamonn deLisser and Horst Baier's Farr 395 "Senara," with only the Miami to Havana Race remaining on the Series schedule. On the strength of its sweep of both the Wirth Munroe Palm Beach Race and the Ft. Lauderdale to Key West Race, Anson Mulder's Oyster 575 "24 Heures" has entered the leaderboard tied with White Rhino in the top spot, but is not entering the Havana Race, a requirement for Series scoring.

Heidi and Steve Benjamin's TP52 "Spookie is entered in the Havana Race, and jumped into the mix to join just two points off of Senara's pace, to match the other TP52, Michael D'Amelio's "Denali". Mike Kayusa's Farr 30 "Raven" lurks one more point back, but has not entered the Havana Race.
